BNA DATABASES

These databases provide current awareness, analysis, case reports, legislation, statutes, regulations, and more. Although their primary focus is labor and employment, they cover the immigration aspect of those subjects as well as all the others.

You must access them through the Law Library's website because BNA uses internet protocol verification. You can also access them from home. Go to the Law Library's website. Click on conduct research. Click on UCLID Off-Campus Access. Enter your UC ID number and last name. Click on Libraries, on Law Library, and then conduct research. Then scroll down to Law Links by Title and Law Links by Subject. Click on one of those and select the BNA database you want to use.

Construction Labor Report (BNA, Feb. 14, 1996-)

Daily Labor Report (BNA, 1994-)

BNA says that this database "...covers legal developments, labor and employment legislation, regulations affecting the workplace, human resource trends, and labor-management relations -- from Congress, the courts, unions, businesses, the NLRB, EEOC, and Labor Department.

Employment Discrimination Report (BNA, Jan. 3, 1996-)

This database includes only a few cases and news reports related to immigrants and aliens.

Employment Discrimination Verdicts & Settlements (BNA, Jan. 1996-)

Human Resources Report (BNA, Feb. 6, 1996-)

Labor and Employment Law Library (BNA)

This is the largest and most complex of the BNA Labor and Employment databases. It contains components on arbitration; contract clauses; disabilities; fair employment; individual employment rights; labor relations; and wages, hours, and leave. Different components began on different dates. It has its own classification system that can be browsed or searched. You can search the full-text or headnotes of

cases. It provides the latest news, primary sources, and fully documented essays on major topics in labor and employment law.
