* This new metropolitan rate supersedes the former reciprocity rate for students residing in the following northern Kentucky counties: Boone, Bracken, Campbell, Carroll, Gallatin, Grant, Kenton, and Pendleton. Matriculated graduate/professional students defined by the University of Cincinnati as residents in these counties now qualify for the metropolitan rate which is resident tuition and fees plus \$120 per semester.
